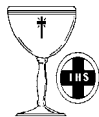

At the point of today's reading in Mark's Gospel, Jesus begins his journey to the cross and resurrection. It is clear that the disciples finally understand that Jesus is the messiah, but they still see this role as one of royal earthly glory. When Jesus corrects this image and explains that the Son of man must suffer rejection and death, Peter takes Jesus aside. Peter can't believe such things could happen to someone destined to greatness and argues with Jesus. Jesus knows these things must happen and tells Peter to get behind him and follow. To follow, Peter, the disciples, and all who have come after them, must suffer as a servant for God, putting others before themselves.

Our Lady of Sorrows

Our Lady of Sorrows, the Sorrowful Mother or Mother of Sorrows, and Our Lady of the Seven Sorrows or Our Lady of the Seven Dolours are names by which the [Blessed Virgin Mary](#) is referred to in relation to sorrows in her life.

By inserting the feast into the [Roman Catholic calendar of saints](#) in 1814, [Pope Pius VII](#) extended the celebration to the whole of the [Latin Church](#). It was assigned to the third Sunday in September. In 1913, [Pope Pius X](#) moved the feast to [September 15](#), the day after the [Feast of the Cross](#). It is still observed on that date.

The Seven Sorrows are events in the life of the Blessed Virgin Mary which are a popular devotion.

It is a common devotion for Catholics to say daily a [Hail Mary](#) for each.

5. [The Crucifixion](#), where Mary stands at the foot of the cross. (John 19:25)
6. [The Descent from the Cross](#), where Mary receives the dead body of Jesus in her arms. (Matthew 27:57)
7. The [Burial](#) of Jesus. (John 19:40)

You can still register your child by coming by the office during office hours.

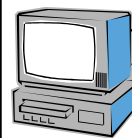
