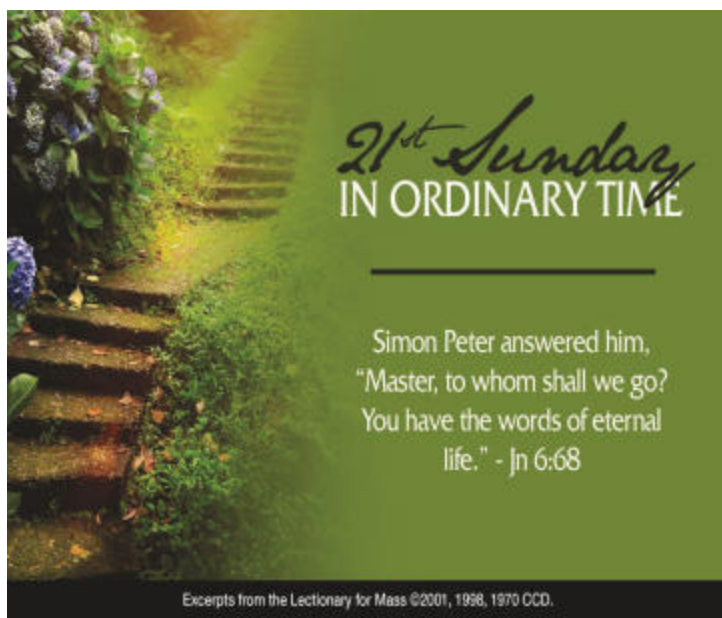
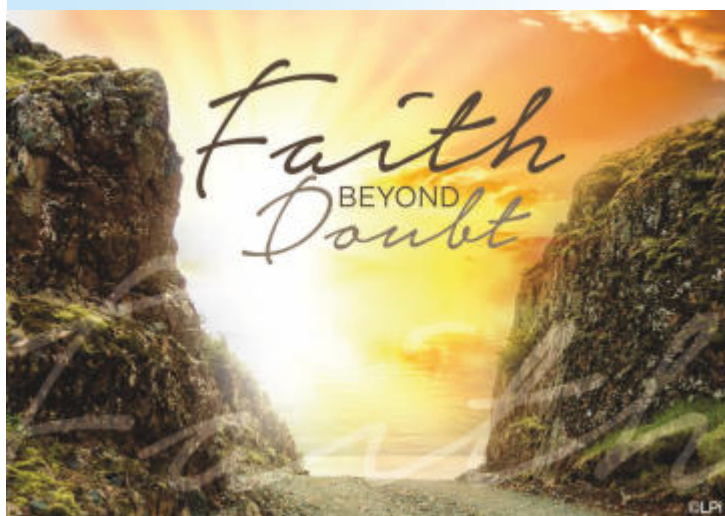

Pray For The Sick of our Parish

"This saying is hard; who can accept it?" The words of Jesus' disciples in today's Gospel must sound familiar. At some point in our lives, you and I have said it about some article of our faith. Christianity makes firm demands on our ethical behavior and gives no easy answers for suffering. Many disciples were confused and dismayed by Jesus' words in the Bread of Life Discourse. Not all of them, however, had the same reaction. When the disciples question Jesus' teaching, he confirms its truth. "The words I have spoken to you are spirit and life." For some, Jesus' reassurance was not enough. These disciples do not question Jesus further or wrestle with their lack of understanding. The mighty deeds Jesus has done fade to the background. "Many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him." For them, their doubt proves too much. Jesus turns to the Twelve, knowing that confusion lives in their hearts as well. Peter answers. "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." Notice this is not a confession of perfect understanding. It is a confession of faith in Jesus. The precise words may still confuse them, but they believe the One who said them. In our own lives, we face doubt, confusion, and disillusionment in our Christian faith. The same choice available to the disciples is available to us. Do you have faith in Jesus, even when you lack perfect understanding? Will you stay or will you go? What do you do with your doubt?

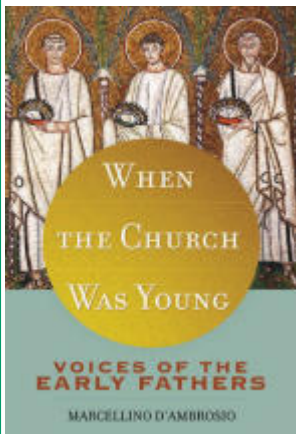
### WELCOME TO ST. HYACINTH CHURCH

## SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

### FOR CHILDREN AND THEIR PARENTS AT ST. HYACINTH CHURCH

### REPORTS OF ABUSE IN THE AMARILLO DIOCESE

The Roman Catholic church is concerned with the well-being of all people, but has a special concern for those who are most vulnerable and cannot fully care for themselves. It is the policy of the diocese of Amarillo that child abuse, including sexual abuse of minors, is contrary to Christian principles and will not be tolerated. If you observe or have reason to believe that a child has been subjected to abuse by any employee or volunteer of the diocese of Amarillo, please note the following:

If the victim is under the age of 18:

- Texas law requires you to immediately notify the nearest police officer, law enforcement agency or Child Protective services (CPS)

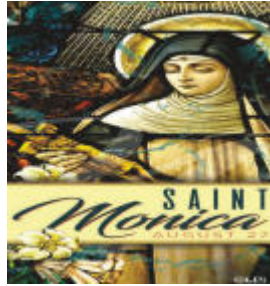

This week we celebrate two saints, a mother and son: St. Monica and St. Augustine. As a young Christian woman, St. Monica was married to a pagan. Early in their marriage, he was bitter and critical. After nearly 20 years, Monica's holy example led to his conversion to Christianity. In the meantime, Augustine was a teenager beginning to live a wild life of self-indulgent excess. This lifestyle would continue into his adulthood. Like with her husband, Monica prayed and fasted for the conversion of her son. Augustine met another future saint, the bishop Ambrose of Milan, who greatly influenced his perspective on life. Augustine was baptized a Christian! Augustine later became a bishop and one of the most influential thinkers in Christian history. How's that for the power of patience and intercessory prayer?
